

## Parfait Dyeing

1. Use a center pull ball that fits in a 1-quart, plastic container – like a cottage cheese or yogurt container.
2. Mix  $\frac{1}{2}$  C soda ash water with  $\frac{1}{2}$  tsp dye and mix well
3. Placed center pull ball in 1 quart container, add dye solution
4. When all the dye has been absorbed remove the center pull ball
5. Mix  $\frac{3}{4}$  cup soda ash water and  $\frac{1}{2}$  tsp dye, mix well
6. Place the center pull ball undyed side down in the container and add dye solution
7. When all the dye is absorbed, you can put it in a plastic bag or keep it in the container
8. Wait 24 hours. Rinse in cold water and remove as much dye as possible. Squeeze to remove as much water as possible. Place between 2 thick towels and step on it. You want to get as much water out as possible.
9. Carefully wind into a skein (a skein winder made of PVC pipe is good for this). Tie securely in several places. Rinse until water is clear. Hang to dry
