

For Sale: 48" Macomber Loom

This was my mom's work horse of a loom. In the end she was only using 4 shafts but she had it set up for at least 12 at one time and all the parts are there for up to 16 shafts. The front and back fold up for a smaller foot print when not weaving. Sturdy enough for rugs it is also easy to weave with a light touch for finer fabrics. Was originally owned by Lucy Haenke who was awarded one of the first ever Certificate of Excellence from HGA in 1976.

There are two warp beams and a detachable second back beam along with reeds, shuttles, bobbins, extra heddles and books. One of my favorite parts is the handle on the beater. Also comes with a Leclerc bench with cushion.
