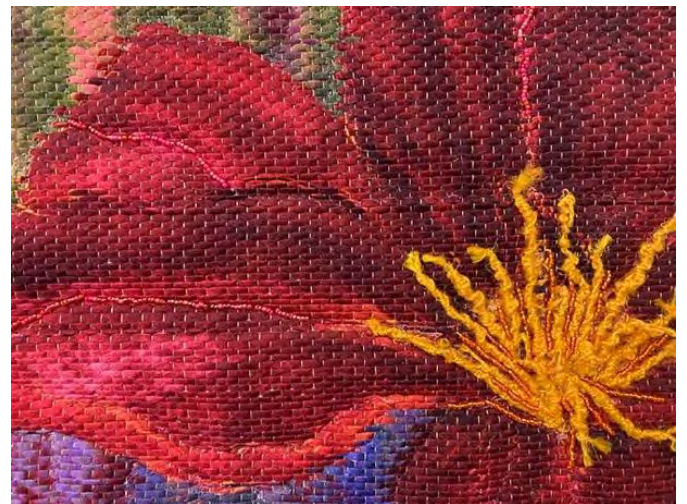
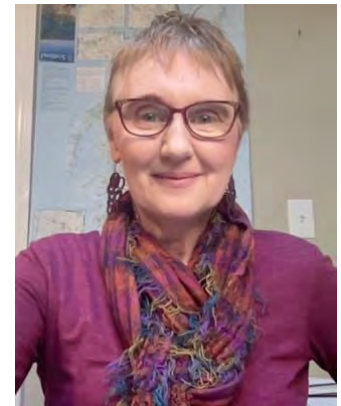
**NOV. 14 "Theme and Variations: A Pictorial History of the Theo Moorman Technique" with Nadine Sanders**

This talk will explore the creative Moorman technique which uses two sizes of warp to allow freeform design inlay on the surface of a fabric as it is woven. Along with the narrated PowerPoint presentation, it will include live music from Nadine and hands-on examination of samples.

**Nadine Sanders**, known as "the Singing Weaver," weaves clothing, rugs and wall hangings with a focus on pictorial design. She makes art quilts that combine weaving and quilting. Writings, songs, photography, people, and wilderness outings inspire her designs.

She has presented over 150 workshops, programs, and retreats in the U.S., Canada, and the United Kingdom. Nadine teaches because she loves to help students realize their creative potential. She also leads "Threads, Ruins and Tunes" tours in Scotland.

Nadine and her mentor/co-author Joyce Harter wrote two books about the Theo Moorman weaving technique. Nadine created the DVD and companion booklet *Warping on a Shoestring*. Her formal education was in fiber arts at the Oregon School of Arts and Crafts in Portland, OR. and Speech-Communications from St.Olaf College, Northfield, MN.
